- Special services throughout our Church's year, e.g. Harvest, Christmas and Easter
- Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion
- Our church organisations
- What our church does in the community

This competition is open to children of primary school age and can be either an individual or a group entry

This competition is open to young people of secondary school age and must be an individual entry.

Entrants might consider interviewing the Rector and other people involved in the life of the Church. Relevant pictures, diagrams, photographs etc. can be included. Entries should be on A4 paper. All entries must be original, the work of those entering and must be handwritten.
